I would like to take this opportunity to inform our customers of a new program that Interstate Ag Plastics is offering. The past two years have been a very labor intensive fact finding and social mission. We have added a new division to our company IAPW, Interstate Ag Plastics West. In the past Interstate Ag Plastics has only been able to recycle triple rinsed pesticide containers from quart size up to 55 gallon drums. Well, that has now changed!

I am pleased to announce that on September 10th, 2011, our new company Interstate Ag Plastics West was awarded the Intermediate Bulk Container Pilot Program by the U.S. EPA for the State of California. This program was geared towards the recycling of Intermediate Bulk Containers (IBCs) that range in size from 250 gallons up to 330 gallons in size.

Our processes are unmatched because of the money we save our customers and the needed service we provide. We have developed a new way of recycling these types of containers. We have designed and developed a cutting edge new truck that is capable of washing, recycling, reconditioning and DOT Leak Proof Testing these containers onsite. So instead of you sending your containers hundreds of miles to a facility that deals in these containers, save yourself some money and let the facility come to you.

Earlier this year our label was approved by the California Department of Regulation for Rinsate Management. Therefore, when these containers are cleaned, the rinsate is managed in such a way that hazardous waste disposal fees are a thing of the past.

As mentioned above, for a short time Interstate Ag Plastics West services were free to our Customers, chemical company Members and others alike, courtesy of the U.S. EPA. But now the program has ended and that free ride is over. In order for us to come to your facility we must have a minimum of 50 IBCs. There is a minimal charge per container but very affordable. This is a first come first serve basis so don't wait to take advantage of this new and exciting program.

If you need to get rid of IBCs that are not compliant with the newly effective August 16th EPA Container and Containment Regulations, if your IBCs need to be reconditioned, and/or DOT Leak Proof Tested then please fill out the attached form in its entirety and fax, mail or email it back to us along with the required documentation. Once we receive the form someone from IAPW will be in contact with you. Or just give us a call if you would like to learn more about the IBC recycling program, 661-764-9614. GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS

Mini Bulk / IBC Container Services - 250- 330 Gallons-Pesticide Container Collection

Location: We come to you. Register to schedule an on-site service.

Interstate AG Plastics is proud to bring this new service to our customers and others alike through our new company Interstate AG Plastics West. The service we are providing is done in a way that eliminates hazardous waste disposal fees and transportation cost, making it an affordable and responsible way of recycling your containers. Interstate Ag Plastics West adheres strictly to all ANSI/ASABE S-596 standards. Please read the following, and if you have any question please contact us.

Program Details

1. All Containers must be pre-registered prior to service visit.
2. Containers must meet eligibility and preparation requirements as listed below.
3. Registration is on a first come, first serve basis. So if you need service and other companies are ahead of you then you will have to wait.
4. MSDS sheets are required with the registration form if containers need to be cleaned by Interstate AG Plastics West. If not available please contact us at 661-764-9614.
5. Interstate AG Plastics West reserves the right to reject any containers that do not meet the eligibility or preparation requirements or any federal, state and/or local regulations.

Eligible Containers

1. One-way or obsolete, high-density polyethylene (HDPE) mini-bulk or intermediate bulk (IBC) containers
2. Once contained pesticides or fertilizers
3. Properly decontaminated prior to service visit, note Preparation Requirements below.

Preparation Requirements

1. Containers are preferred to be triple rinsed prior to the IAPW service visit but not necessary.
2. If Containers have not been triple rinsed and need to be recycled then all containers that are identifiable must have MSDS provided to IAPW prior to service visit.
3. For customers who prefer that IAPW handles the triple rinse/recondition step, they must have a place to store the rinsate, i.e. spray rig or holding tank.
4. If the containers are unidentifiable and need to be triple rinsed prior to being recycled, then the location where the service is performed must have a DTSC permit for disposal of Hazardous Waste. Make sure all containers are identifiable or be able to relay what chemical was last stored in it.
5. If the containers have been triple rinsed, then they must be marked/labeled as having been triple-rinsed with a label and not an ink marker. Please refer to 'Safely Cleaning Refillable Pesticide Containers for Recycling,' A brochure developed by the Ag Container Recycling Council (ACRC), CLA and EPA, is available at www.acrecycle.com
6. The customer to be serviced must segregate all containers by chemical type and if they want IAPW to remove the containers then all labels must be removed before IAPW will commence operations, this includes all paper and all glue on the plastic or metal plate attached to the IBC.
