To whom it may concern,

The California Food and Agriculture Code (FAC) section 12841.4 (a) requires persons who are the first to sell an agricultural-use or structural-use pesticide product for use within the state of California that is packaged in a HDPE container of 55 gallons or less to establish a recycling program or demonstrate their participation in a recycling program.

Interstate Ag Plastics is in a position to satisfy these needs. In the past three years interstate Ag Plastics has been a private contractor for the Ag Container Recycling Council. We adhere strictly to the ANSI-ASABE Standard S596 entitled Recycling Plastic Containers from Pesticide and Pesticide- Related Products published February 2006. We currently have numerous recycling programs in approximately 25 different counties of which all are overseen by the California Department of Agriculture. Our recycling programs service approximately 275 different collection sites of which are comprised of landfills, agricultural chemical dealerships, farming operations and agricultural service companies. In our program, we offer the required Department of Pesticide Regulations supporting documentation followed by reports and accurate accounts of where the recycled plastic is shipped.

In 2008 Interstate Ag Plastics achieved a very high recycling rate of the total plastic pesticide bottles sold in California and that rate is growing. Interstate Ag Plastics has developed an affordable program that will satisfy the requirements of the Department of Pesticide Regulations. The program was developed in a membership pool type manner. In January 2010 a recycling rate will be established making each first seller of an agricultural-use or structural-use pesticide recycle a certain percentage of the total plastic containers sold in California. With the amount of plastic containers supplied by each company via questionnaire, a recycling rate will be established for the total pool. Depending on the amount of pesticide containers a company sells in California will determine the amount that will be billed each quarter along with an annual membership fee.

Interstate Ag Plastics is a company that prides itself on service and communication. Enclosed is a basic information form for an authorized representative from your company to fill out so that we may better understand your company's needs. Once we receive the questionnaire we will contact your company's authorized person by phone to give an affordable quote for our services. If your company needs to join a recycling program that adheres to all of the ANSI-ASABE S-596 Standards in recycling used pesticide containers then please consider joining our program.
