I would like to take this opportunity to inform our Customers, Members and others alike of a new program that Interstate AG Plastics is offering. The past two years have been a very labor intensive fact finding and social mission. What I mean by that is that we have added a new division to our company. In the past Interstate Ag Plastics has only been able to recycle triple rinsed pesticide containers from quart size up to 55 gallon drums. Well, that has now changed.

I am pleased to announce that on September 10th, 2011 Interstate Ag Plastics was awarded the Intermediate Bulk Container Pilot Program by the U.S. EPA for the state of California. This program is geared towards the recycling of Intermediate Bulk Containers (IBCs) that range in size from 275 gallons up to 330 gallons in size.

Our processes are unmatched because of the money we save our customers and the needed service we provide. We have developed a new way of recycling these types of containers. We have designed and developed a cutting edge new truck that is capable of washing, recycling, reconditioning and ultrasonically DOT Leak Proof Testing these containers on- site. So instead of you sending your containers hundreds of miles to a facility that deals in these containers, save yourself some money and let the facility come to you.

Earlier this year our label was approved by the California Department of Regulation for rinsate Management. Therefore, when these containers are cleaned the rinsate is managed in such a way that hazardous waste disposal fees are a thing of the past.

As mentioned above, for a limited time Interstate Ag Plastics will be offering our service to our Customers and Members at a fraction of the original price, courtesy of the U.S. EPA. In order for us to come to your facility we must have a minimum of 50 IBCs. The pilot program will start the 1st of November, 2011 and will end on January 31st, 2012. This is a first come first serve bases so don't wait to take advantage of this program.

If you need to get rid of your IBCs that are not compliant with the newly effective August 16th Container and Containment Regulations or if your IBCs need to be

reconditioned and or DOT Leak Proof Tested then please fill out the attached form in its entirety and fax, mail or email it back to us along with the required documentation. Once we receive the form someone will be in contact with you. Or just give us a call if you would like to learn more about the IBC recycling program. Thank you and we look forward to continue servicing you in the years ahead.





GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS

Pilot Pesticide Container Collection

Dates: November 1st, 2011 –January 31st, 2012

Location: We come to you- register to schedule an on-site service.

Interstate AG Plastics is working with EPA Region 9 in collaboration with the CA Department of Pesticide Regulation (CDPR) and the Western Plant Health Association (WPHA) to conduct a Pesticide Intermediate Bulk Container pilot pesticide container recycling program. This event is intended to collect data and information for the future development of programs to safely recycle eligible pesticide containers.

Program Details

1. A \$10.00 charge per container for service of containers, whether it is recycling or cleaning and recycling.
2. All Containers must be pre-registered prior to service visit.
3. Containers must meet eligibility and preparation requirements as listed below.
4. Registration is on a first come, first serve basis. There is a cap rate to the number of containers that can be collected during this event. Once we reach that cap then the program ends so please register early to ensure your containers are included.
5. MSDS sheets are required with the registration form if containers need to be cleaned by Interstate AG Plastics West. If not available please contact Brad Bittleston at 661-764-9614.
6. Interstate AG Plastics reserves the right to reject any containers that don't meet the eligibility or preparation requirements or any federal, state and/or local regulations.

Eligible Containers

1. One-way or obsolete, high-density polyethylene (HDPE) mini-bulk or intermediate bulk (IBC) containers
2. Once contained pesticides - fertilizer containers are NOT being collected at this pilot event
3. Are not currently being used or that may not meet the new requirements of the Federal, Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA) that went into effect August 16th, 2011.
4. Properly decontaminated prior to service visit, note Preparation requirements below

Preparation Requirements

1. Containers are preferred to be triple rinsed prior to service visit but not necessary
2. If Containers have not been triple rinsed and need to be recycled then all containers that are identifiable must have MSDS provided to Interstate AG Plastics prior to service visit.
3. If the containers are unidentifiable (i.e. no label) and need to be triple rinsed prior to being recycled then that location where the service is being performed must have a DTSC permit for disposal of Hazardous Waste.
4. If the containers have been triple rinsed then they must be marked/labeled as having been triple-rinsed 'Safely Cleaning Refillable Pesticide Containers for Recycling,' a brochure developed by the Ag Container Recycling Council (ACRC), CLA & the EPA, is available at www.interstateagplastics.com

Instructions:

If the IBCs and their chemical contents are unidentifiable and need to be cleaned then the rinsate generated from the cleaning process must be disposed of as Hazardous Waste and the site we perform operations on that needs to have Hazardous Waste disposed of needs to have a current DTSC permit.

Any customer that needs to have IBCs rinsed/cleaned by Interstate Ag Plastics on-site must provide MSDS of chemical contents in those IBCs before operations can begin.
